My name is Mr. Kelsey Missick, Chief Petty Officer for the Royal Bahamas Defence Force. I am writing this recommendation letter on behalf of Jaydian J. Miller, a former colleague of mine at the Leadership Development Institute (LDI) at Baha Mar in 2013 and current Soft Skills Presenter representing the National Training Agency (NTA) for our Bahamas National Youth Guard (NYG) program held at the Royal Bahamas Defence Force base.

In 2013, Jaydian and I worked together for the Leadership Development Institute (LDI) at Baha Mar which was a program that assisted disadvantaged young adults between the ages of 16-24 years old. I was responsible for training the participants in Discipline and Physical Exercise and Mr. Miller trained them in Parenting and Civics. Mr. Miller demonstrated a high level of care for each trainee and provided mentorship outside of his training sessions to many participants who needed it. As a result of Mr. Miller's hard work and dedication to our trainee's success, he was promoted to Program Manager for the LDI Day and Night Sessions. He was also responsible for interviewing over five hundred trainees to determine which Practical Skills Discipline they would move into after Soft Skills Training. Once all of the trainees had me been placed, Mr. Miller was given the role of Assistant Principal of LDI Hospitality which required him to do weekly checks to ensure that trainees were reporting to their workstations daily and on time, completing the work that was assigned to them, being treated fairly and with respect, provided with the necessary tools to be successful and much more. At the end of the year, we were able to train over one-thousand of our nation's youth with six hundred and fifty successfully completing the program.

In 2024, I was able to work with Jaydian again as he moved on to the National Training Agency which does the same type of training that the Leadership Development Institute (LDI) provided for our nation's youth. He served as a Soft Skills Facilitator for Cohorts 2 and 3 of our Bahamas National Youth Guard (NYG) program. He trained our current Cohort 3 trainees on Managing Workplace Diversity and the Importance of Community Outreach which are important topics because of our demographic. Mr. Miller has been a valuable asset and we look forward to working with him again for future Cohorts.

Mr. Miller has demonstrated a consistent and committed approach to helping young people over the past 11 years. I hold Jaydian in high regard and it is with great pleasure to write this letter to recommend him as a Leadership Trainer.

Jaydian worked with me when I was the Human Resources Project Executive for Baha Mar focused on the startup of the Leadership Development Institute and the employing entity – HHCO at Baha Mar.

He did such a great job that I hired him months later when I had an opening for a program manager. Management was a natural role for Jaydian and he had a passion for making a difference. He worked relentlessly during a time period when we doubled the size of the program to coordinate all logistics, teach, hold students accountable, mentor and most importantly act as a role model.

- Extremely dedicated and determined to succeed at whatever he goes after

- Is one of the most respectful people I know, people could learn from his demeanor


